TOWN OF LITTLE ELM'S CONSENT

COMES NOW the Town of Little Elm, Texas (the "Town") and files this consent to the decertification of the Town's sewer CCN that lies within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Hackberry ("Hackberry"), and would show the following:

BACKGROUND

1. On June 9, 2015, Hackberry, filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas, (the "Commission") an application to obtain a new sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Denton County, Texas.

2. On July 9, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the application identifying deficiencies in the Application. One of the deficiencies noted by the Staff is that a portion of the sewer CCN area requested by Hackberry application over laps a sewer CCN held by the Town and a portion of the corporate limits as shown on the attached maps.

3. All of the over lapping area is the subject matter of an ETJ and CCN Agreement between the Town and Hackberry dated October 23, 2013.

4. On October 3, 2014, the Town filed an application under Docket No. 43452 to amend the Town's water and sewer CCNs. The intent of the Town's application, among others, was to adjust the Town's water and sewer CCN consistent with the Town's Agreement with Hackberry.

5. Because the Town's application is still pending, the Town is executing this consent in order that Hackberry's sewer CCN application may move forward without further delay.






Exhibit B to Hackberry's Second Amendment to Application and Response to Notice of Mapping Deficiencies





Exhibit C to Hackberry's Second Amendment to Application and Response to Notice of Mapping Deficiencies
