**ORDER NO. 10
DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendations regarding the sufficiency of the application, provision of notice, and proposed procedural schedule for continued processing. Commission Staff recommended that the City of Hackberry's application be deemed sufficient for further review following the City of Hackberry's supplemental filing on February 19, 2016. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the City of Hackberry's application is administratively complete.

Commission Staff also recommended that the City of Hackberry proceed with provision of notice as described in its March 31, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Heidi Graham and Tracy Montes of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the attached forms. Consistent with Staff's recommendation, the City of Hackberry shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's recommendation and file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

Commission Staff recommended a proposed procedural for continued processing of this application. Accordingly, the procedural schedule set out below is adopted:

Deadline for the City of Hackberry to file proof of notice, including affidavits and a sample of the notice and map that was issued	May 2, 2016 ¹
Deadline for the City of Hackberry to file proof of permission to serve from North Texas MWD	May 2, 2016
Deadline for parties other than Commission Staff to intervene, request a hearing, or file comments	30 days from the issuance of notice
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation or additional procedural schedule	June 15, 2016
