COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Request for Additional Time. In Support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On June 9, 2015, City of Hackberry (City or Applicant) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to obtain a new sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Denton County. The proposed project consists of a new sewer system to serve an area of approximately 1,035 acres and 1,182 current customers. The proposed service area is located approximately six miles west of downtown Frisco, Texas.

Order No. 17 allowed the parties until January 31, 2016 to file a joint proposed notice of approval.

II. REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

Staff determined additional consent forms were need from the parties in this case. Staff transmitted consent forms to the City of Little Elm on January 31, 2017. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that the parties be allowed until February 14, 2017 to file a joint proposed notice of approval.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request.
