**Subject:** Docket No. 44820: *Application of the City of Hackberry for a sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Denton County*

On June 9, 2015, City of Hackberry (Applicant) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to obtain a sewer CCN in Denton County, pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC) §§13.242-13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§24.101-24.107.

Staff has reviewed the above referenced application and have found that it is deficient in the required mapping information; therefore, staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively incomplete due to the items discussed below.

### **Mapping**

The Applicant should provide the following items:

1. A general location (small scale) map showing only the proposed service area with enough detail to accurately locate the service area within the nearest city, town or county.
2. A large scale map showing only the proposed service area with enough detail to accurately locate the service area in the vicinity of surrounding roads, streets, and highways.
3. Revised digital data only including the proposed service area in a drawing (DWG) file format on a data disk (CD). The revised digital data should correspond to the same proposed service area as shown on the revised small and large scale maps.
  - a. The digital submitted with the application shows overlaps with the CCN boundaries of the City of Frisco, CCN 20591, and the Town of Little Elm, CCN 20931. The Applicant should provide revised digital data removing the areas of overlap.

- b. The Applicant's proposed area overlaps corporate boundaries of the City of Frisco, Town of Little Elm and The Colony. The Applicant should provide agreements or consent granted by each city for the area of overlap or submit revised digital data removing the areas of overlap.
- c. The proposed digital data must be a single, continuous polyline or polygon record, which is clearly labeled as the proposed service area.
- d. The proposed digital data must include the projection or coordinate system used to create the digital data.
