COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Supplemental Recommendation. In support of its Supplemental Recommendation, Staff states the following:

I. Background

Childress Creek Water Supply Corporation (Childress Creek WSC) requests that the Commission decertify a portion of the service area certificated under water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11000. The service area is in Bosque County, Texas.

On April 16, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge entered Order No. 2, which found Childress Creek WSC's application not administratively complete due to certain deficiencies identified by Staff.

On March 17, 2016, Childress Creek WSC submitted additional mapping information in response to Order No. 2.

II. Supplemental Recommendation

Staff has reviewed the additional mapping information submitted by Childress Creek WSC, and Staff recommends that the Commission deem Childress Creek WSC's application to be administratively complete.¹ With regard to notice, Staff recommends that Childress Creek WSC provide notice to the following:²

a. Any districts, utilities and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed service area;

- b. Any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction that overlaps the proposed service area;
 - c. The county judge of each county in the proposed service area;
- d. Any groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed service area;
 - e. Bosque County;
 - f. Brazos River Authority; and
 - g. Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.

Childress Creek WSC should include with the notice of its application a copy of a map that shows the proposed service area(s) with enough detail to accurately locate the proposed service area(s) in reference to verifiable man-made and/or natural landmarks such as roads, railroads, and rivers.

In addition to providing notice to the entities listed above, Staff recommends that Childress Creek WSC publish notice of its application once each week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Bosque County, Texas.

III. Procedural Schedule

To assist in the processing of Childress Creek WSC's application, Staff requests that the Commission adopt the following procedural schedule:

Event	Deadline
Deadline for Childress Creek WSC to file affidavits regarding the provision and publication of notice	May 20, 2016
Deadline for Staff to file a supplemental procedural schedule	June 3, 2016
Intervention deadline and deadline for intervenors to file comments or request a hearing	30 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later

IV. Conclusion

Staff recommends that the Commission deem Childress Creek WSC's application administratively complete and adopt the proposed procedural schedule detailed above.

On June 16, 2015, Childress Creek WSC (Applicant) filed an application to decertify a portion its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11000 in Bosque County pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.102 through 24.105 (TAC) and Tex. Water Code § 13.246(c) (TWC). The purpose of the application is to decertify the proposed area so that VM Neighbors Water Group, who currently provides service to eight customers located in the proposed area, can proceed with their filing to obtain exempt registration status in Docket No. 44849.

Staff has reviewed the maps submitted on March 17, 2016, and finds the application administratively complete and sufficient for filing pursuant to 16 TAC §§24.8. Staff recommends the following:

- 1) The Applicant to provide correct notice of the application to the following:
 - any districts, utilities and cities within two (2) miles of the proposed service area;
 - any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area;
 - county judge of each county;
 - any groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partly included in the proposed area;
 - publish notice once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Bosque County.

The 2-mile notice list is incomplete. Notify the entities shown below **in addition** to the neighboring entities listed in the application:

- Bosque County
- Brazos River Authority
- Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District
- 2) The Applicant should include a copy of a map with the individual notices to neighboring utilities, other affected parties, and each landowner. The map should show **only** the proposed service area(s) with enough detail to accurately locate the proposed service area(s) in reference to verifiable man-made and/or natural landmarks such as roads, railroads, and rivers. It is the Applicant's burden to provide an accurate map delineating

the proposed service area with each individual notice. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained by the Applicant from the TCEQ web site located at http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/

Within 30 days of the Commission order, the Applicants should submit a copy of the actual notice issued, the map issued with the individual mailed notice, tear sheets of the newspaper notice, and the signed affidavits (copies attached), indicating that the notice was given.

Additional financial or technical information may be requested through future correspondence that will be addressed during Staff's technical review of the application. Failure to provide the requested information may delay processing of the application.
