I. BACKGROUND

On June 16, 2015, Childress filed an application with the Commission to decertify a portion of the area served by its certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11000 in Bosque County, Texas. On April 15, 2016, Commission Staff recommended that the Commission deem the application administratively complete and recommended procedures for Childress to provide notice and proof of notice to specific entities. Staff also recommended a procedural schedule with a deadline of May 20, 2016 for Childress to provide proof of the provision and publication of notice. On April 20, 2016, the Commission deemed the application administratively complete and schedule.

II. PROOF OF NOTICE





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
