COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Supplemental Procedural Schedule. In support of its Supplemental Procedural Schedule, Staff states the following:

I. Background

Childress Creek Water Supply Corporation (Childress Creek WSC) requests that the Commission decertify a portion of the service area certificated under water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11000. The service area is in Bosque County, Texas.

On April 20, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge entered Order No. 6, which deemed Childress Creek WSC's application administratively complete and required Childress Creek WSC to provide and publish notice of its application.

On May 19, 2016, Childress Creek WSC filed affidavits regarding the provision and publication of notice of its application. Childress Creek WSC provided notice of its application to affected parties on April 26, 2016. Childress Creek WSC published notice of its application in the *Clifton Record* on April 27, 2016 and May 4, 2016.

II. Supplemental Procedural Schedule

To assist in the processing of Childress Creek WSC's application, Staff requests that the Commission adopt the following procedural schedule:

| Notice completed | May 4, 2016 |
| Deadline for intervention | June 3, 2016 |
| Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Childress Creek WSC for review and consent | August 1, 2016 |
| Deadline for Childress Creek WSC to file signed consent forms with the Commission | August 15, 2016 |
| If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application | August 22, 2016 |
| If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file a proposed notice of approval that includes proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law | August 29, 2016 |

III. Conclusion

Staff requests that the Commission adopt the proposed procedural schedule detailed above.




