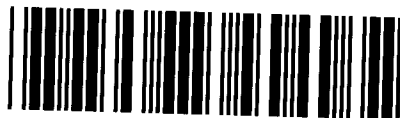

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

I. Application

On June 16, 2015, Childress Creek Water Supply Corporation (Childress Creek) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to decertify a portion of Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11000 in Bosque County.

II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application

On July 15, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is not administratively complete because it contained material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's July 14, 2015 recommendation.

Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that Applicant be given until August 14, 2015 to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate, by September 14, 2015.


IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Childress Creek's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **August 14, 2015**, Childress Creek shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **September 14, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
