**ORDER NO. 3
GRANTING APPLICANT'S REQUEST FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO DEFICIENCIES**

On June 16, 2015, Childress Creek Water Supply Corporation (Childress Creek) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to decertify a portion of Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11000 in Bosque County.

On July 16, 2015, the Commission issued Order No. 2, Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Establishing Deadlines and Opportunity to Cure.

On August 14, 2015, Applicant filed an amended application in response to Order No. 2 and request for extension of time to respond to mapping deficiencies in the application. Applicant explained that they will need to contract with mapping or survey professionals to prepare maps and data necessary for Commission Staff to be able to accurately locate the area to be decertified. Applicant stated they have discussed the issue with Staff and Staff has no objection to the request for extension of time to complete the necessary maps.


Childress Creek's request for extension of time until **November 13, 2015** to complete and submit maps and data to the Commission is granted.

Commission Staff's September 14, 2015 deadline, established in Order No. 2, to file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application is also extended until **December 14, 2015**.
