ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION COMPLETE AND SUFFICIENT;
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On June 16, 2015, Sunset Water, LLC (Sunset) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for a rate/tariff change within Moore County. Sunset proposed an effective date of August 15, 2015.

I. Commission Staff's Comments on Administrative Completeness

On July 16, 2015, Commission Staff recommended the application and notice be deemed administratively complete and sufficient, and that the new rate may go into effect on August 15, 2015. Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of Sunset's application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Sunset's application and notice are deemed administratively complete and sufficient. Sunset may implement the proposed rates, effective August 15, 2015, subject to a final Commission determination on the reasonableness of such rates.

II. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule is adopted for this proceeding:

Effective date of rate change	August 15, 2015
Deadline for ratepayers or any affected parties other than Staff to file comments, intervene, or request a hearing	November 13, 2015
Deadline for Staff to request a hearing or make a final recommendation on the Application, including a supplemental procedural schedule	November 23, 2015
Deadline for Applicant to respond to Staff's Recommendation or deadline for parties to submit a joint proposed notice of approval	December 2, 2015
Deadline for Commission to request a hearing	December 14, 2015

Filings

Parties are reminded that an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk according to P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties.

III. Communications

Parties are also reminded that direct communications with the administrative law judge are prohibited. Questions concerning this order or any other order must be submitted in writing, filed with the Commission, and served on all parties of record.
