

DEEMING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT; ADDRESSING NOTICE AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Application

On August 25, 2015, Terra Southwest Inc. (Terra Southwest) and the Town of Little Elm (Little Elm) filed supplemental information to cure deficiencies in its application as identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

II. Administrative Completeness

On September 18, 2015, Commission Staff filed additional comments on the sufficiency of the amended application and notice. Commission Staff finds that the application and notice, as amended, are sufficient for further review. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application and notice are deemed administratively complete.

III. Notice

Commission Staff recommended that the parties provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Consistent with Staff's recommendation, Applicants shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's September 18, 2015 filing consistent with the corrections and criteria outlined in the attached memorandum of Leila Guerrero and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the form attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. Applicants shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.


IV. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule is adopted:

Deadline for Applicants to file affidavits attesting to mailed and published notice along with a copy of the notice sent	October 19, 2015
Deadline for affected persons to file a written protest or to intervene, deadline for affected persons to file comments, and deadline to request a hearing on the merits	Within 30 days of mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later
Deadline for Commission Staff to file an updated procedural schedule	October 26, 2015
