**ORDER NO. 7
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation finding the amended application administratively incomplete. Commission Staff commented that the City of Lubbock's (Lubbock) application remains deficient and is not administratively complete as specifically described in Commission Staff's March 11, 2016 filing and the attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia and Tracy Montes of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division.


Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Lubbock should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **April 8, 2016**, Lubbock shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **May 9, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule if the application is deemed administratively complete.
