**ORDER NO. 8
FINDING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT, REQUIRING NOTICE
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's recommendation that the application of the City of Lubbock (Lubbock) be deemed administratively complete and sufficient for further review. Commission Staff indicated that the Lubbock should be required to provide notice and proof thereof as instructed in the attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia and Tracy Montes of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff provided the correct forms for notice by publication and by mail, and for proof of notice. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for further processing of this application.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Lubbock's application is deemed sufficient and accepted for filing. Lubbock shall provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner and form described in Commission Staff's May 9, 2016 recommendation. Additionally, the following schedule shall apply:

Deadline for Lubbock to provide the Commission with the affidavits of notice, including a copy of the individual notice issued with the accompanying map, and a copy of the published notices	June 9, 2016
Deadline to intervene, and deadline for intervenors to file comments or to request a hearing	30 days after mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and updated procedural schedule based upon the date notice was issued	July 8, 2016
