**ORDER NO. 9
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ADOPTING
UPDATED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On May 31, 2016, the City of Lubbock (Lubbock) filed an affidavit of notice, along with a copy of the notices sent, and an affidavit verifying publication of notice. According to the affidavits, notice was mailed to neighboring systems, landowners and cities on May 18, 2016, and published in the *Lubbock Avalanche Journal* on May 15 and May 22, 2016. On July 8, 2016, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed comments on the sufficiency of Lubbock's notice. Commission Staff recommended that the notice be found sufficient. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Lubbock's notice is deemed sufficient.

The procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:

Notice completed	May 22, 2016
Deadline for intervention	June 21, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicant for review and consent	August 22, 2016
Deadline for Lubbock to file signed consent forms with the Commission	September 8, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	September 15, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed notice of approval including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	September 29, 2016
