**ORDER NO. 10**  
**ADOPTING REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's unopposed request for extension of time and proposed procedural schedule. Commission Staff stated they are unable to provide a final recommendation at this time because additional mapping information from the City of Lubbock (Lubbock) remains outstanding. Commission Staff and Lubbock continue to work towards resolution of all outstanding issues and Staff recommends that Lubbock be given additional time to cure the mapping deficiencies. Further, Commission Staff requested to extend the deadline for Staff to file its final recommendation to November 18, 2016. The request is granted.

The revised procedural schedule proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:

Deadline for Lubbock to file revised mapping documentation for the proposed sewer CCN	October 3, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on the revised mapping documentation filed by Lubbock	October 19, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicant for review and consent	November 1, 2016
Deadline for Lubbock to file signed consent forms with the Commission	November 14, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	November 18, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed notice of approval including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	December 2, 2016
