## JOINT STATUS REPORT AND PROPOSED REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and the City of Lubbock (Lubbock) (collectively the Parties) file this Joint Status Report and Proposed Revised Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, the Parties show the following:

## I. Background

On June 30, 2015, Lubbock filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its water certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 10627 in Lubbock County, Texas pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC), §§13.242-.250 and the 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) §§24.101-107. On October 28, 2015, the City filed an amended application to amend its water CCN No. 10627 and its sewer CCN No. 20230.

On October 21, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 10 abating the proceeding and requiring the Parties to file a status report and a new procedural schedule by October 28, 2016. Accordingly, this pleading is timely filed.

### II. Status Report

The Parties continue to work towards resolution of all outstanding issues. Specifically, Staff mapping personnel has been working with Lubbock to resolve the mapping deficiencies, noting that processing of the application could not proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

## III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

The Parties proposes the following revised procedural schedule for final processing of the application:

Event	Date
Deadline for Lubbock to file revised mapping documentation for the proposed sewer CCN.	November 10, 2016
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on the revised mapping documentation filed by Lubbock.	November 18, 2016
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Lubbock for review and consent	December 12, 2016
Deadline for Lubbock to file signed consent forms with the Commission	December 23, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	January 3, 2016
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	January 17, 2016

## IV. Conclusion

The Parties respectfully requests that an order be issued consistent with this pleading.
