

**COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION FINDING
REVISED MAPPING SUFFICIENT**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Supplemental Recommendation finding Revised Mapping Sufficient. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. Background

On June 30, 2015, the City of Lubbock (Lubbock) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its water certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 10627 in Lubbock County, Texas pursuant to Texas Water Code Ann. (TWC), §§13.242-.250 and the 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) §§24.101-107. On October 28, 2015, the City filed an amended application to amend its water CCN No. 10627 and its sewer CCN No. 20230.

On November 1, 2016, Order No. 12 was issued unabating the docket and requiring Lubbock to file revised mapping documentation for the proposed sewer CCN by November 10, 2016. On November 15, 2016, Lubbock filed revised mapping documentation for its proposed sewer CCN. Order No. 12 also required Staff to file a recommendation on the revised mapping documentation filed by Lubbock by November 18, 2016. Accordingly, this pleading is timely filed.

II. Supplemental Recommendation on Administrative Sufficiency

Staff has reviewed the revised mapping documentation filed by Lubbock. As supported by the attached memorandum from Patricia Garcia, Staff Engineer, and Tracy Montes, GIS Specialist with the Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff recommends that the revised mapping documentation be deemed sufficient.

(TWC), §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and the 16 Tex. Admin Code (TAC) §§24.101 to 24.107.

On November 15, 2016, the City filed mapping information removing an overlap with JE Franklin Trust's sewer CCN No. 20743 from the proposed sewer CCN area. Staff has reviewed the documentation and notes the filing is sufficient.
