- 5. The City's publisher's affidavit and the affidavit of mailed notice to customers, neighboring systems, cities and other affected parties in Lubbock County, filed on May 31, 2016 (AIS Item No. 25).
- 6. Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition, filed January 3, 2017
 (AIS Item No. 42)
