**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,**  
**ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

**I. Application**

On June 30, 2015, the City of Lubbock (City) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10627. Order No. 1 required Commission Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice.

**II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application**

On July 30, 2015, Commission Staff filed comments on the application. Commission Staff has determined that the application is not administratively complete because the application was submitted on the wrong form, and the mapping contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's July 30, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Lisa Fuentes, Patricia Garcia, and Tracy Harbour, of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.


**III. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure**

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the City's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **August 31, 2015**, the City shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **September 30, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule
