## ORDER NO. 4 THIRD NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

On November 18, 2015, in response to Order No. 3, Denton County Municipal Utility District No. 7. (Applicant) amended its application in response to deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff

## I. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Amended Application and Notice

On December 4, 2015, Commission Staff commented on the amended application. Commission Staff has determined that the application remains deficient and not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's December 4, 2015, filing and the attached memorandum of Tracy Montes and Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

## II. Finding Amended Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **January 6, 2016**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

On or before January 27, 2016, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness.
