ORDER NO. 7 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's recommendation on sufficiency of the application of Denton County Municipal District No. 7 (applicant) to obtain new water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity.

I. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Amended Application and Notice

On April 29, 2016, Commission Staff commented on the amended application and determined that the application remains deficient and not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's April 29, 2016, filing and the attached memorandum of Tracy Montes and Jolie Mathis of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

II. Finding Amended Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before May 17, 2016, applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

On or before **June 15, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness.
