ORDER NO. 11 SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE; AMMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order address the sufficiency of notice provided by Denton County Municipal Utility District No. 7 (Denton County MUD 7). Commission Staff recommended the notice be found insufficient because it was not provided to five entities that are within the 2-mile buffer of the proposed water and sewer service areas that must receive individual mailed notice.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the notice is deficient. Denton County MUD 7 shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's September 26, 2016 recommendation and file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.

The procedural schedule is amended as follows:

| Deadline for parties to file comments, intervene or request a hearing | 30 days after mailed or last published notice, whichever is later |
