ORDER NO. 3 SECOND NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

I. Background

On September 17, 2015, in response to Order No. 2, the City of Mount Pleasant (Applicant) amended its application to cure deficiencies identified by Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff.

III. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Amended Application and Notice

On October 16, 2015, Commission Staff commented on the amended application. Commission Staff has determined that the application remains deficient and not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's October 16, 2015, filing and the attached memorandum of Fred Bednarski and Tracy Harbour of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

IV. Finding Amended Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **November 16, 2015**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

On or before **December 16, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness.
