

## Sewer Capacity Analysis

KSA spoke with Heidi Graham of the Public Utilities Commission of Texas on September 21, 2015. Ms. Graham stated that she required further information regarding whether or not the City of Mount Pleasant Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) could handle the wastewater flow from the additional 57 residential connections to be added during the annexation process. KSA performed an analysis of the capacity of the City of Mount Pleasant's WWTP as summarized in Table 1 below:
