ORDER NO. 4 ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Application and Notice

On July 22, 2015, Twin Lakes Water Supply (Twin Lakes) filed an application to obtain a new water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Tarrant County, Texas. On October 23, 2015, Order No. 3 was issued, finding the application sufficient for further review, and among other things, establishing a November 23, 2015 deadline for Twin Lakes to file proof of notice and a January 5, 2016 deadline for Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff to file a supplemental procedural schedule and/or make a recommendation on final disposition of the application.

II. Commission Staff's Recommendation

On January 5, 2016, Commission Staff responded to Order No. 3, stating that the proof of notice provided by Twin Lakes was not sufficient. Additionally, Commission Staff stated that Twin Lakes has not demonstrated adequate technical capability to be granted the requested CCN, as specifically described in the attached memorandum of Heidi Graham, in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff recommended that Twin Lakes be required to submit documentation to address the identified notice and technical issues.

III. Procedural Schedule

Twin Lakes is instructed to provide the information Commission Staff requires to complete its review of the application. The following procedural schedule is adopted:
