COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Recommendation and Proposed Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 22, 2015, Twin Lakes Water Supply (Twin Lakes or Applicant) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application (Application) to obtain a new water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Tarrant County, Texas.

Order No. 9 allowed the Applicant until December 16, 2016 to file a status update. The Applicant filed a status update on January 2, 2017 indicating that it waiting to hear from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) regarding the well exception. Order No. 9 instructed Staff to file a recommendation by January 6, 2016.

II. RECOMMENDATION AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends, in light of the fact that the Applicant is working with TCEQ to resolve an outstanding issue, that the Applicant timely file a detailed status update, documentation resolving the well issue, and/or a request for additional time by February 6, 2017 and that Staff file supplemental recommendation by March 6, 2017. If the ALJ finds this proposed procedural schedule too protracted and indefinite, Staff would not oppose dismissal without prejudice.

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IV. CONCLUSION


Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order consistent with the above recommendations.


