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**ORDER NO. 10
REQUIRING DETAILED STATUS UPDATE AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES**


This Order addresses Commission Staff's January 5, 2017 recommendation that Twin Lakes Water Supply be required to file by February 6, 2017 a status update or documentation demonstrating that the issue in its application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for an exception to well requirements has been resolved. Commission Staff cannot complete its technical evaluation of this application until the TCEQ well requirement issue is resolved. Commission Staff proposed to file a supplemental recommendation by March 6, 2017, and did not oppose dismissal of this application without prejudice if the proposed deadlines are too protracted.

Commission Staff's comments about the protracted nature of the proposed deadlines are correct. However, before dismissal is considered, Twin Lakes is given the opportunity to provide more specific information. Accordingly, on or before **February 6, 2017**, Twin Lakes shall file a status update that includes specific information with regards to its efforts to resolve its TCEQ well requirement issue and a realistic timeframe for when resolution can be expected, or documentation demonstrating that the issue has been resolved. On or before **March 6, 2017**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation and/or propose dismissal or an additional procedural schedule, as appropriate.

Twin Lakes is advised that failure to file a timely response to this Order could result in dismissal.
