## COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 2

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 2.

#### I. Background

On August 6, 2015, Spring Creek Trails LLC (Spring Creek) and Springlife Waterwell (Springlife) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County (Application) pursuant to Tex. Water Code Ann. §§ 13.301, 13.246, and 13.301 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.102, 24.109, and 24.112 (TAC). The Applicants seek approval for Spring Creek's retail water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11444 and associated facilities to be transferred to Springlife.

On September 9, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 2 deeming the application administratively incomplete. On October 13, 2015, the Applicants filed supplemental documents. Order No. 2 also required Staff to file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule by November 5, 2015. Therefore, this Response is timely filed.

## II. Recommendation on Administrative Completeness

As explained in the attached memorandum (Attachment A) of Debbie Reyes Tamayo and Kristy Nguyen of the Water Utilities Division, Staff has reviewed the supplemental filings and recommends that the Application be deemed sufficient for filing.

Staff has also attached the notice (Attachment B) the Applicants must provide to any districts, groundwater conservation districts, counties, utilities, cities, cities with an extraterritorial jurisdiction within two miles of the proposed service area, any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area, and any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the requested area. In addition to those systems identified in the application, Staff recommends that the Applicants also provide notice to the entities listed in Attachment A.

Further, Staff has attached the affidavit (Attachment C) the Applicants must sign and file with Commission after providing notice in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.112(c). Additionally, the Applicants should provide an accurate map delineating the proposed area with each mailed notice. At this time, Staff recommends that the Applicants be allowed to proceed with providing notice for the proposed transaction and be given until **December 8, 2015** to file a copy of the actual notices issued, the map issued with the mailed notices, and a signed affidavit that the notice was given.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

On August 6, 2015, Spring Creek Trails LLC (Spring Creek or Seller) and Springlife Waterwell (Springlife or Buyer) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application with the Commission for approval of the sale, transfer or merger (STM) of facilities and service area of water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11444. As a result of the transaction, Spring Creek's water CCN No. 11444 will be cancelled. In addition, Springlife will acquire the facilities and service area from Spring Creek and will be registered as an exempt utility with the Commission. The application is being reviewed pursuant to the criteria in the Tex. Water Code Ann. §§ 13.241, 13.246, and 13.301 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.102, 24.109, and 24.112 (TAC).

#### **Notice Requirements**

- 1. Staff reviewed the information provided by the Applicants submitted on August 6, 2015, and recommends the Applicants be ordered to provide notice of the application to the following:
  - a) any districts, groundwater conservation districts, counties, utilities, cities, cities with an extraterritorial jurisdiction within two miles of the proposed service area;
  - b) any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area; and
  - c) any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the requested area.

Affected persons may file written protests and/or request a public hearing within 30 days of this notice.

To request a hearing, you must:

- (1) state your name, mailing address and daytime telephone number;
- (2) state the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application;
- (3) include the statement "I/we request a public hearing";
- (4) write a brief description of how you, the persons you represent, or the public interest would be adversely affected by the proposed transaction and transfer of the CCN; and
- (5) state your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Only those persons who submit a written request to be notified of a hearing will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled. The Commission will issue the CCN requested in the referenced application unless a hearing is scheduled to consider the transaction. If no protests or requests for hearing are filed during the comment period, the Commission may issue the CCN 30 days after publication of this notice.
