

The Lumberton Raiders clinched a spot in the playoff on Friday with a 28-13 win over Vidor.

The Lumberton (7-2) have shown a huge improvement after winning three games last year and going winless the two yearn before. In the first quarter, Caleb Thomas scored from four yards out. Ben Eppes kicked the PAT and Lumberton had a 7-0 lead.


