ORDER NO. 9 REQUIRING COMPLAINANT REPLY

This Order addresses Commission Staff's May 25, 2017 status report and recommendation regarding this proceeding.

Commission Staff reported that Resilient Assets, LLC filed records from January 2014 through January 2015 that included the water bill from the City of Freeport, the allocation calculation of the charge per resident, and the rent roll that included the number of occupants per apartment. Commission Staff stated that, although a short time period remains for which records have not been provided (February and March of 2015), the information submitted substantially satisfies the request of Ms. Boniaby to make the records available to her. Commission Staff recommended, absent anything further from Ms. Boniaby, the complaint should be closed.

In light of the preceding, Ms. Boniaby shall file, not later than July 6, 2017, a reply whether the information provided satisfies her complaint, and if so, a withdrawal of the complaint.
