## NOTICE OF INTENT TO SERVE DECERTIFIED AREASEP 18 AM 11: 10

Notice is given to the public of the filing with the Public Utility Commission Conference (Commission) on September 14, 2015, of notice of intent to serve a 494.819-acre tract in Denton County.

Docket Style and Number: City of Celina's Notice of Intent to Provide Water and Sewer Service to Area Decertified from Mustang Special Utility District in Denton County, Docket No. 45151.

The Application: On September 14, 2015, pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.113(i), the City of Celina filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) notice of its intent to serve a 494.819-acre tract in Denton County that was decertified from water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) Number 11856 and sewer CCN Number 20930 held by Mustang Special Utility District. The 494.819-acre tract at issue was decertified pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.254(a-5) (TWC).

TWC § 13.254(a-6) provides that the Commission may require an award of compensation to a decertified retail public utility that is the subject of a petition filed under TWC § 13.254(a-5). TWC § 13.254(e) provides that the monetary amount of compensation, if any, shall be determined at the time another retail public utility seeks to provide service in the previously decertified area and before service is actually provided. Further, the Commission is required to ensure that the monetary amount of compensation is determined not later than the 90th calendar day after the date on which a retail public utility notifies the Commission of its intent to provide service to the decertified area.
