ORDER NO. 6 FINDING APPLICATION CONTINUES TO BE INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the City of Austin's application. Commission Staff recommended that the application remains deficient. Commission Staff further recommended dismissal of the application for failure to prosecute unless Austin supplements its application to correct deficiencies previously identified by a date certain. Should Austin comply with this request, Commission Staff proposed to file a supplemental recommendation thereafter.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Austin's application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **June 6, 2016**, Austin shall supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff in its March 4, 2016, recommendation and accompanying memorandum. Processing of this application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. If Austin does not supplement its application by the preceding deadline, the application will be dismissed for failure to prosecute.

Should Austin supplement its application as required, Commission Staff shall file, on or before **July 8, 2016**, a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of this application, sufficiency of notice, recommendation regarding how the application should be processed, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
