ORDER NO. 8 DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, ADDRESSING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application, addressing notice, and a procedural schedule proposal. On June 24, 2016, the City of Austin filed supplemental mapping information.

Commission Staff recommended that the application as well as the supplemental mapping information be deemed administratively complete and that the City of Austin be required to provide notice consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation and the attached memorandum of Elisabeth English and Tracy Montes of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the included notice forms.

For the foregoing reasons, the application is deemed administratively complete. The City of Austin shall provide notice consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation and attached memorandum, using the attached notice forms. The City of Austin shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.
