COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION THAT APPLICATION BE APPROVED

Comes now the staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 9. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On September 9, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 9, requiring Staff to request a hearing or file a final recommendation on or before October 20, 2016. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the application be approved. As detailed in the attached memorandum (Attachment A) from Elizabeth English, Engineering Specialist in the Commission's Water Utilities Division, the Applicant has provided sufficient evidence that it possesses adequate financial and technical capability to provide continuous and adequate service. Also attached to this pleading are signed consent forms (Attachment B), the CCN service area map (Attachment C), and CCNs (Attachment D).

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above and in the attached memorandum, Staff recommends that the application be approved. Staff will work with the parties to file a joint proposed notice of approval by November 3, 2016 as required by Order No. 9.

On September 21, 2015, the City of Austin (City) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application requesting to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 20636 and Aqua Water Supply Corporation's (WSC) sewer CCN 20962 in Travis County, Texas. The application is being reviewed under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248 and 16 Tex. Admin. Code §24.117 (TAC).

Pursuant to TWC § 13.248, contracts between retail public utilities designating areas to be served and customers to be served by those retail public utilities, when approved by the Commission after public notice and hearing, are valid and enforceable and are incorporated into the appropriate areas of the CCN.

Proper notice of the application was published in the *Austin American-Statesman* on August 3 and August 10, 2016, as noted in the affidavit filed on August 24, 2016. Proper notice was provided to neighboring utilities and affected parties in Travis County on July 27, 2016. The comment period ended September 23, 2016, and no protests or requests for hearing were received.

The total area to be transferred is approximately thirty-seven (37) acres and does not include any current customers. The effect of the proposed amendment is that it would amend the existing CCN boundaries of both the City and the WSC. A portion of the City's CCN sewer service area, approximately 37 acres, would be transferred to the WSC. There are no facilities, or existing customers of the City's that are currently in the area that would be transferred to the WSC. There are no other retail public utilities of the same kind that would be affected by the proposed transaction. Granting the proposed amendment meets the expectations of both WSC and the City as they have jointly entered into an agreement to transfer 37 acres from the City to the WSC. As a result of this application, the WSC's service area will be expanded by approximately 37 acres and the City's CCN will be reduced to remove the area.

The WSC has the financial and technical capability to provide continuous and adequate service to the proposed area. A financial review found that the WSC has adequate financial and managerial capability to provide continuous and adequate service to the area subject to this application plus the area already certificated to the WSC.

Staff has considered the WSC's ability to provide continuous and adequate service pursuant to the CCN criteria outlined in TAC § 24.102(d). Pursuant to the requirements set forth in 16 TAC § 24.117, Staff recommends the following:

- 1) Approve the application and grant the CCN amendments as requested in the application; and
- 2) Provide the attached certificates and maps to the City and the WSC.


