Hi, my name is Kenneth R Stewart Jr. of Irving, Texas. PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

My father's was Kenneth J. Stewart who separated Sears Holding Co. from Allstate Insurance Co with Ed Liddy and Tom Wilson in the 1990's, along with taking Allstate public in 1995. In fact, up to last month, my father's photo on horseback overlooking the Colorado River was hanging in the Texas Department of Insurance in their front office lobby. I'm not sure why after 30 years it was just recently taken down. My father was a creator from the get-go, just like Sam Walton. He mysteriously died in early 2004.

In addition to Allstate Insurance, my father partnered with HL Hunt, Trammell Crow, and Magnum Entertainment to open Lone Star park in Grand Prairie, as well as opening Trucker's Companies and K&K Trucking and Transportation which became a subsidiary of ATC Freightliner after merging with Associates Financial Corp. In addition, and relevant here, my father was an initial partner in Texas Competitive Electrical Co., which became TU Electric Co. which become TXU with its multitudes of wholly owned subsidiaries including Luminant, Energy Future Holdings, etc.

Currently, I am appealing pro se the Energy Future Holdings bankruptcy case for multiple reasons, while objecting here to the PUC why ONCOR/EFH/TXU et al is not worthy to operate any utility in TEXAS:

1. I am the Registrant for Edison International Inc. who was the original parent of TXU, EFH and many others entities. My father placed me in this position when I was 25 years old.
2. The Texas Creditors in the Delaware Court are not getting a fair deal in the pro-Debtor Delaware courts.
3. EFH et al is not performing any due diligence on Creditor's specific material requests of claims even when instructed by the Judge.
4. Furthermore, as pointed out to the Judge, TXU court document's have the last 4 digits of my SS number. As confirmed by the District Court Clerk their historical case has a lot to do with me.
5. Lastly, and most important here to the EFH bankruptcy case, and to all of their entities, including ONCOR, is the fact that I have held since 1993, the Nuclear Insurance Policy Inclusion in my 100 page commercial policies.

Upon presenting this information to the PUC in December 2015, I was told it sounds like I must be TXU but since that information has been concealed from the Public and sealed in the AG's office since 2007 to protect the Individual, no one actually knows for sure. So the PUC and I have submitted a Freedom of Information request to the AG's office to release said named holder, now pending.

I have documents stating Allstate Insurance, KKR and a Texas Attorney General colluded to not report to the public who is this individual. Furthermore, I have requested to the FBI and the Texas Rangers to assist the PUC and I in retrieving said policyholder name, though my 100 page document says me.

Lastly, we have all watched the Delaware based companies, yet Texas Operators, EFH, TXU, Luminent and other subsidiaries file bankruptcy after bankruptcy and bleed the Texas Creditors and economy for the great preferred benefits of a few. I stand here today to predict the future that ONCOR and more Hunt Family entities will continue this exact same game plan multiple times in the future starting with ONCOR.

So I leave you with this:

All future Texas Utilities for Electric Generating, Transmissions, and Marketing entities must be Texas only domiciled companies from this point forward so to protect all of the Texas Creditors and Consumers from predatory operators.
