**ORDER NO. 6**

**FINDING APPLICATION CONTINUES TO BE INCOMPLETE AND  
DEFICIENT; ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the above-styled and numbered joint application. Specifically, Commission Staff determined that the application remains administratively incomplete because it contains additional material deficiencies, as described in Commission Staff's April 12, 2016, filing and the attached memorandum of Sean Scaff and Kristy Nguyen of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(a); thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

Commission Staff proposed that City of Edinburg be given until May 12, 2016, to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Commission Staff proposes to file a supplemental recommendation regarding completeness of the amended application on June 12, 2016.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, City of Edinburg's amended application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **May 12, 2016**, City of Edinburg shall amend the application to cure the additional deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **June 13, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if deemed administratively complete.
