COMMISSION STAFF'S PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Proposed Procedural Schedule and Request for Additional Time. In Support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On September 30, 2015, the City of Edinburg (Edinburg) and North Alamo Water Supply Corporation (North Alamo WSC) (collectively, Applicants) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) a joint application (Application) to amend Edinburg's water certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 12106 and to decertify a portion of North Alamo WSC's water CCN No. 10553 in Hidalgo County. The amendment will enable Edinburg to include approximately 40 acres of land and zero current customers.

Order No. 8 instructed Staff to file a recommendation by July 25, 2016.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

Staff is in the process of preparing a final map, and, therefore, request additional time to accommodate the following proposed procedural schedule.

Deadline for parties to file a joint proposed notice of approval, if a Staff recommendation for approval is made	September 20, 2016


III. CONCLUSION
