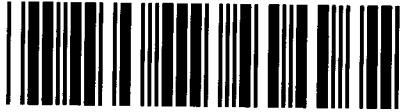

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

I. Application

On September 30, 2015, Kempner Water Supply Corporation (Kempner) and the City of Copperas Cove (the City) (together the Applicants) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Coryell County.

II. Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness of the Application

On October 30, 2015, Commission Staff recommended that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's October 30, 2015 filing and the attached memorandum of Andrew Novak and Tracy Montes, of the Commission's Water Utilities Regulation Division. 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a)(TAC), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

III. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff did not propose a procedural schedule at this time, but instead proposed that Applicants be given additional time to address the deficiencies identified by Commission Staff. Processing of this application cannot proceed until the items requested by Commission Staff are received and reviewed. After Applicants have supplemented the

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
application, Commission Staff proposes to provide a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and propose a procedural schedule at that time, if appropriate.

IV. Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient, Providing Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, this application is deemed incomplete and deficient. On or before **December 4, 2015** Applicants shall supplement the application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. On or before **December 11, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
