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RATEPAYERS' APPEAL OF THE DECISION BY TROPHY CLUB MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 TO CHANGE RATES

TROPHY CLUB MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1'S COMMENTS AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

In accordance with Order No. 1, Trophy Club Municipal Utility District No. 1 files these comments and proposed procedural schedule and would respectfully show the following:

SUFFICIENCY OF PETITION

On October 8, 2015, retail customers of Trophy Club Municipal Utility District No. 1 (the "<u>District</u>") filed a petition pursuant to Section 13.043(b) of the Texas Water Code entitled "MUD Petition to Appeal Rates Established by the Board of Directors" (the "<u>Petition</u>"). Public Utility Commission ("<u>PUC</u>") Rule 24.41 governs the Petition, and PUC Rule 24.42 sets forth the required contents for petitions for review of rate actions filed pursuant to Texas Water Code §13.043(b).¹ In relevant part, PUC Rule 24.42 requires that a petition for review of rate actions contain the following:

1) A clear and concise statement that the petition is an appeal of a specific rate action of the water or sewer service supplier in question as well as a concise description *and date of that action*;

2) The name, telephone number, and street or rural route address (post office box numbers are not sufficient) of each signatory ratepayer. The petition shall list the address of the location where service is received if it differs from the residential address of the signatory ratepayer;

3) The effective date of the decision being appealed;

- 4) The basis of the request for review of rates; and
- 5) Any other information the Commission may require.²

PUC Rule §24.42(a)(1) specifically requires that a rate appeal petition brought under Texas Water Code §13.043(b) include the date of the action being appealed. The Petition that was filed in this proceeding fails to specify the date of the action being appealed. As a result, the Petition fails to meet the requisite elements of a rate appeal petition established by PUC rules and is insufficient to trigger PUC jurisdiction. The Petition must be dismissed.

The PUC must first determine whether the Petition is valid before proceeding with the case.

PROCESSING THE PETITION

If the PUC concludes that the Petition is valid and satisfies the requirements found in Texas Water Code, Section 13.043, Subsections (b), (c) and (d), the Petition must be processed as provided in Subsection (e) of that Section,³ which provides for a de novo proceeding in which the PUC fixes rates at the level that those rates should have. However, the PUC is limited to considering only the information that was available to the District at the time it made its decision and evidence of reasonable expenses incurred in the appeal proceedings.⁴ In addition, the PUC must ensure that the rates are just and reasonable, and not unreasonably preferential, prejudicial, or discriminatory.⁵ The PUC must also "use a methodology that preserves the financial integrity of the retail public utility" and recognizes the District's determination of customer classes.⁶

PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

If the Commission determines that the Petition is valid and takes jurisdiction, then the District recommends that the following schedule be established for consideration of the Petition:
