- The commission cannot grant a CCN until proper notice of the application has been given. Commission rules B. do not allow a waiver of notice requirements for CCN applicants.
- It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that proper notice is given to all entities that are required to receive C. notice.
- D. Recommended notice forms for publication, neighboring cities and systems, landowners with 25 acres or more, and customers are included with this application for use in preparing proposed notices. (Notice forms are available in Spanish upon request.)
- After reviewing and, if necessary, modifying the proposed notice, the commission will send the notice to the E. applicant after the application is accepted for filing along with instructions for publication and/or mailing. Please review the notice carefully before providing the notice.
- F. **Notice For Publication:**
 - The applicant shall publish the notice in a newspaper with general circulation in the county(ies) where a CCN is being requested. The notice must be published once each week for two consecutive weeks beginning with the week after the notice is received from the commission. Proof of publication in the form of a publisher's affidavit shall be submitted to the commission within 30 days of the last publication date. The affidavit shall state with specificity each county in which the newspaper is of general circulation.
- G. Notice To Neighboring Utilities:

Investor Owned Utilities (IOUs) that are currently providing service without a CCN must provide individual mailed notice to all current customers. The notice must contain the current rates, the date those rates were instituted and any other information required in the application.

 The commission may require the applicant to deliver notice to other affected persons or agencies.

Do not publish or send copies of the proposed notices to anyone at the time you submit the application to the commission. Wait until you receive written authorization to do so. Authorization occurs after the commission has reviewed the notices for completeness, and your application has been accepted for filing. Once the application is accepted for filing, you will receive written authorization to provide notice. Please check the notices for accuracy before providing them to the public. It is the applicant's burden to ensure that correct and accurate notice is provided.

Name of Applicant <u>Woodland Hills Water Company L.L.C.</u> has filed an application for a CCN to obtain or amend CCN No.(s) <u>12388</u> with the Public Utility commission of Texas to provide <u>water</u> utility service in <u>Liberty County</u>.

NORTH PROPERTY

The North property to be added is an area consisting of approximately 634 acres (71.7241 acres + 562.5784 acres) located approximately 3.4 miles northeast of the City of Dayton bounded generally as follows: on the north by Liberty County Road 6350, on the South by US Highway 90, on the east by the Trinity River and on the West by Farm to Market Road 1008

SOUTH PROPERTY

The South property to be added is an area consisting of approximately 62 acres located approximately 8 miles southwest of the City of Dayton and is bounded generally as follows: on the north by County Road 4882, on the south by County Road 4876 on the east by County Road 487 and on the west by the Harris/Liberty county line.

The total area being requested includes approximately 634 acres and 0 current customers.

You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number; (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application; (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing;" (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN; and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application or CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All requests to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a metes and bounds description of the tract of land.
