ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS OF THE PETITION AND NOTICE, REQUESTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND OTHER PROCEDURAL MATTERS

I. Application

On October 16, 2015, House Hahl Commercial Owners Association filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for exempt utility registration pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.242(c) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.103(d) (TAC).

II. Requiring Comments on Administrative Completeness of Application and Procedural Schedule

On or before **November 16, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the application, how the petition should be processed, and propose a procedural schedule, if necessary.

III. Filings

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk according to 16 TAC § 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as provided in 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange, http://interchange.puc.texas.gov.

All parties shall provide their current addresses, telephone and facsimile numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party shall provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and facsimile information if such information changes. The telephone and facsimile numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for



updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

IV. Ex Parte Communications

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.3(b)(2) ex parte communications with the administrative law judges and presiding officer (collectively, ALJs) are prohibited. Parties shall communicate with the ALJs only through written documents filed with the Commission's Filing Clerk and served on all parties. Questions concerning this order or any other order must be submitted in writing, filed with the Commission, and served on all parties of record.
