DEEMING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT; ADDRESSING NOTICE AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff's recommendation on the sufficiency of the application filed by Zipp Road Utility Company, LLC (Zipp Road) to obtain a new sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Guadalupe County.


On May 2, 2016, Commission Staff recommended that this application be deemed sufficient for further review. Commission Staff stated Zipp Road should be required to provide notice and proof of notice using the forms and in the manner detailed in the attached memorandum of Elisabeth English and Kristy Nguyen, in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for further processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Zipp Road's application is sufficient and accepted for filing. Zipp Road shall provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner and form described in Commission Staff's May 2, 2016 recommendation. Additionally, the following schedule shall apply:

Deadline for Zipp Road to file a copy of the notice sent to affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation with attached signed affidavits that the notice was given	June 15, 2016
Deadline for intervention, deadline for intervenors to file comments or request a hearing on the merits	30 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and further disposition	June 27, 2016
