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# COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Request for an Extension of Time. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On October 21, 2015, Zipp Road Utility Company, LLC (Zipp Road) filed with the Commission an application to obtain a new sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Guadalupe County. In Order No. 8, issued June 29, 2016, Staff was ordered to provide a final recommendation by September 14, 2016. On September 1, 2016, Zipp Road filed a letter regarding a settlement with Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA), where Zipp Road will plan on receiving wholesale wastewater service from GBRA while remaining the retail provider. On September 9, 2016, Zipp Road filed revisions to its CCN application to account for this change and GBRA filed a motion to withdraw its opposition to the amended application. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

# II. ADDITIONAL TIME REQUIRED

Due to this application being recently substantively amended, Staff requires additional time to review the new information. Staff requests that it be given until September 27, 2016 to comment on the amended application and provide a procedural schedule.

#### III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request.
