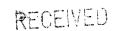

To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this response of SWWC Utilities, Inc. to the Commission's Order No. 1 in the above referenced matter. We have been ordered to cure the deficiencies by January 7, 2016 and therefore this response is timely filed. Our response to each of the alleged deficiencies noted in the staff's memo is provided below by number.

Item 2. Order the Applicants to provide proof that Monarch and Romark paid their Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAF) in full to Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).

RESPONSE: See attached documentation that shows Monarch Utilities I, L.P. paid its regulatory assessment fees for 2014. The regulatory assessment fee for 2015 is not due until January 30, 2016 and Monarch will have paid by then. Also attached is documentation that Romark has paid its fees, including 2015 fees, to the TCEQ.

Item 3. Order the Applicants to complete #13 of the application and to provide a detailed list of the utility plant in service to be transferred to Monarch.

RESPONSE: Attached is a copy of initialed Item 13 of the application. The original was sent to the PUC on November 18, 2015. The list of assets to be transferred from Romark to Monarch is also attached.

Item 4. Order the Applicants to submit a legible copy of Romark's tariff.

**RESPONSE:** Attached are legible copies of the tariff.

Item 5. Order the Applicant to provide confirmation that there are no customers in the area of decertification. Alternatively, if there are any customers in the area of decertification, to provide a description of how each customer's service will or will not be affected;

RESPONSE: Confirming: there are no customers or utility facilities in the area of decertification.

Item 6. Inform the Applicants that:

c. During the technical review phase of the application, the Applicants will be required to provide consent from Trinity River Authority of Texas (Trinity) regarding the proposed overlap with Trinity.

RESPONSE: We are unaware that Trinity has a certificated service area or unaware of any other overlap issues. However, we have contacted the TRA and are working with it to get consent.

And, we will implement appropriately the additional information provided by the staff in Item 6 regarding the notice.

We believe this information should be more than adequate to eliminate the deficiencies noted by the PUC staff. However, please contact me if there are still questions or if any additional information is required.
