#### COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Commission Staff's Second Recommendation on Sufficiency and would show the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On November 20, 2015, the City of Cottonwood Shores (Cottonwood Shores) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 13185 and sewer CCN No. 21051 in Burnet County. Cottonwood Shores seeks to amend its CCNs to provide water and sewer services to an area east of the city limits.

In Order No. 1, issued December 2, 2015, Staff was given a deadline of December 21, 2015 to file a recommendation. On December 2, 2015, Staff filed a recommendation of deficiency. Order No. 2, issued December 22, 2015 found the application administratively incomplete and directed Cottonwood Shores to file an amended application by January 22, 2016, and directed Staff to file a supplemental recommendation by February 19, 2016. Cottonwood Shores filed an amended application on January 19, 2016. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

#### II. RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed Cottonwood Shore's application and, as supported by the attached memorandum of Andrew Novak and Kristy Nguyen of the Water Utilities Division, Staff recommends that the application is administratively complete. Staff further recommends that Cottonwood Shores provide notice as instructed in the attached memorandum.

### III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date	
Deadline for Cottonwood Shores to file affidavits of notice	March 24, 2016	
Deadline to intervene, file comments, or request a hearing	30 days after notice is issued	
Deadline for Staff to file recommendation, request for hearing, and/or an additional procedural schedule	May 4, 2016	

Staff notes that customers have the ability to opt out of a CCN request. In the event customers wish to opt out of the CCN, additional procedures may be needed before Staff may make a recommendation. Additionally, in the event Staff were to recommend final approval of the CCN amendment, Staff's ability to meet the above deadline is driven in part by Staff's receipt of consent to final mapping from Cottonwood Shores. Therefore, Staff's proposed procedural allows Staff the opportunity to either file a recommendation after the customer comment period or provide an additional procedural schedule.

#### IV. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendations.

On November 20, 2015, the City of Cottonwood Shores (Cottonwood Shores) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13185 and sewer CCN No. 21051 in Burnet County. Cottonwood Shores seeks to amend its CCNs to provide water and sewer services to an area east of the city limits. This application is being reviewed pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a) (TAC).

After review of the application, Staff recommends that the application be found sufficient for filing and that Cottonwood Shores be ordered to issue the attached notices as directed below:

- In addition to those entities listed in the application, Cottonwood Shores must also notice
  the following entities located within 2-miles of the outer boundary of the proposed waters
  and sewer service areas requested with this application in accordance with 16 TAC §
  24.106(b)(2):
  - Channel Oaks Water System 12109
  - Wilderness Cove Water Company 12334
  - Colibri Ranches Water System 13155
  - LCRA
  - Burnet County WCID 1
  - Horseshoe Bay WCID 1
  - Meadowlakes
  - Central Texas Groundwater Conservation District
  - Burnet County Judge

- 2) Provide the correct notice of the application to the following in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.106(b)(2):
  - a) any districts, groundwater conservation districts, counties, utilities, cities with an extraterritorial jurisdiction within two (2) miles of the outer boundary of the proposed service areas;
  - b) any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service areas; and
  - c) landowners with more than 25 acres and any affected parties in the proposed CCN area. The landowner information may be obtained from the county appraisal district tax rolls for the county or counties in which the proposed CCN lies; and
  - d) notice to the public which must be published once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Burnet County.
- 3) Include a copy of a map showing the proposed service areas with the individual notices to neighboring utilities, customers and other affected parties. It is the Cottonwood Shore'ss burden to provide an accurate map delineating the proposed service areas with each individual notice. Information related to districts including addresses can be obtained by Cottonwood Shores from the TCEQ web site located at <a href="http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/">http://www14.tceq.texas.gov/iwud/</a>
- 4) File copies of the actual notices sent and signed affidavit (blank forms attached)

Cottonwood Shores should file a copy of the actual notice and map issued with the individual mailed notice, tearsheets of the published notice, and the signed affidavits (copies attached), indicating that the publication and notice was given in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.106(b)(6).

AN ORDER OF BURNET COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 WITHIN THE COUNTY OF BURNET, TEXAS, FINDING THAT THE TRUSTEE HAS REDUCED ALL ASSETS AND RESOURCES OF THE DISTRICT TO POSSESSION AND MONEY AND HAS DISCHARGED THE OUTSTANDING OBLIGATIONS OF THE DISTRICT; DISCHARGING THE TRUSTEE; AND ENTERING THE FINAL ORDER OF DISSOLUTION FOR THE DISTRICT AND FILING OF THE SAME

BURNET COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1	

WHEREAS, the Burnet County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 (the "District") is authorized under Texas Special District Local Laws, Chapter 9030 (the "Special Act") and Chapter 51 of the Texas Water Code, as amended (the "Water Code") to voluntarily dissolve upon a finding of the District's Board of Directors (the "Board") that the proposed undertaking of the District is impracticable or apparently cannot be successfully and beneficially accomplished so long as the District has not authorized construction bonds or the final lending of its credit; and

WHEREAS, the District has held a public hearing in accordance with Sections 51.781(b)-51.783 of the Water Code regarding the dissolution of the District, and after all interested persons had the opportunity to present evidence regarding the dissolution of the District at the public hearing, the Board determined that the dissolution of the District would be in the best interest for the persons and property within the District and ordered the dissolution of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District appointed Brandon W. Meek as Trustee to close the affairs of the District and to reduce all assets and resources of the District to possession and money and apply them to discharge the outstanding obligations of the District; and

WHEREAS, all obligations of the District are paid and the Trustee's account is verified and settled; and

WHEREAS, the District now wishes to enter its final order of dissolution and record this final order in the deed records of Burnet County, Texas.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE DISTRICT:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated in and made a part of this Order by this reference.

- Section 2: The Board has determined that the best interests of the persons and property in the District will be served by dissolving the District, has entered this finding, and has ordered the dissolution of the District.
- Section 3: The Board appointed Brandon W. Meek as trustee to close the affairs of the District. The Trustee has reduced all assets and resources of the District to possession and money and has applied them to discharge the outstanding obligations of the District, having regard to specific funds.
- <u>Section 4</u>: The Trustee has confirmed that all of the District's assets and resources have been reduced to possession and money and has applied them to discharge any outstanding obligations of the District. The Trustee's account is verified and settled, and the Trustee is hereby discharged.
- <u>Section 5:</u> The Trustee's account has been verified and settled, the Board finds that all obligations of the District are paid, and the Trustee is hereby discharged.
- Section 6: The District hereby orders the District dissolved and orders that this Order be recorded in the deed records of Burnet County, Texas.
- Section 7: If any portion of this Order shall, for any reason, be declared invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions hereof and the Board hereby determines that it would have adopted this Order without the invalid provision.
- Section 8: This Order shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so resolved.
