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### COMMISSION STAFF'S ERRATA TO THE COMPLIANCE TARIFF

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Errata to the Compliance Tariff. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

### I. BACKGROUND

On December 17, 2015, Ponder Enterprises Inc. dba Longhorn Co. (Ponder) filed an application (Application) for a price index rate adjustment pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.1872 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.36 (TAC). On January 19, 2016, Staff filed Commission Staff's Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Recommendation on Final Disposition (Staff's Recommendation), recommending that the Application be found administratively complete and that the Application be approved.

On January 26, 2016, Staff filed Compliance Tariff sheets. Staff files this Errata to the Compliance Tariff to correct a typographical error.

### II. ERRATA

Staff's Compliance Tariff inadvertently included a typographical error. The tariff incorrectly listed the street address as "Tom Donald Road." The correct street address is "Tim Donald Road." Staff has corrected this error and included a clean copy of the tariff.

### III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully requests that an order be issued consistent with Staff's errata to the Compliance Tariff.
