**ORDER NO. 3
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order address the application of Edom Water Supply Corporation (Edom WSC) to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10747 in Henderson and Van Zandt Counties to decertify approximately 252 acres of land, to add land to its service area, and seeks dual certification with RPM Water Supply Corporation (RPM WSC).

Commission Staff has determined the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's March 23, 2016 filing and the attached memorandum of Heidi Graham, Gary Horton, and Tracy Harbour of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission. Edom WSC should not publish notice of the application until these discrepancies are corrected and approved by Commission Staff.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation the application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **April 22, 2016**, Edom WSC shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **May 23, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule if deemed administratively complete
