ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the above-styled and numbered proceeding. Commission Staff recommended that the application is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in Commission Staff's filing and attached memorandum of Sean Scaff and Gary Horton of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff further proposed that the City of Gregory (Gregory) be given until June 8, 2016, to address the deficiencies, and for Commission Staff to file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, once the application is deemed administratively complete.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Gregory's application is found administratively incomplete and deficient. In accordance with, 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before **June 8, 2016**, Gregory shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. On or before **July 8, 2016**, Commission Staff shall file additional comments regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if deemed administratively complete.
