**ORDER NO. 5
DEEMING APPLICATION COMPLETE AND SUFFICIENT;
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the City of Gregory's (City) application to obtain a certificate of convenience and necessity in San Patricio County.

I. Commission Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness

On July 8, 2016, Commission Staff recommended that the application be found administratively complete and accepted for filing, and proposed a procedural schedule. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is deemed administratively complete.

II. Commission Staff Recommendation on Notice

Commission Staff has reviewed City's proposed notice with regard to applicable statutes and rules, and recommended that the City provide notice and submit signed affidavits indicating that notice was given, along with a copy of the actual notices issued, within 30 days of the date of notice and last publication date. Consistent with Staff's recommendation, the City shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's July 8, 2016 filing, consistent with the criteria outlined in the recommendation, and using the form attached to the recommendation. Applicants shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice by the deadline set forth below.


III. Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule as proposed by Commission Staff is adopted:

Event	Date
Deadline for applicant to file affidavits of notice; including a copy of the individual notice issued with the accompanying map, and the published notice	August 22, 2016
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and an updated procedural schedule	Within 10 days of applicant filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline for affected persons to file a written protest, comments, and/or request a hearing on the merits	30 days after mailed or last published notice, whichever is later
