Mr. Castaneda,

I was able to resolve the technical errors with the last digital data submitted. As such, please find attached the edited digital data (polygon shapefile) of the requested area for Docket 45489. I have included a version projected in State Plane South so it should import easily to AutoCAD for your review. If things look good and match the intent of the application, with all the landowner opt-outs addressed, then please use that polygon boundary to make two new maps (one small scale and one large scale) of the requested area. In previous map submissions, your team has included the city limits. Please DO NOT include the city limit boundaries on the maps, just the polygon boundary and roads for the requested area.

The PUC will be awaiting your submission of the latest digital data (polygon shapefile) and the two latest maps which correspond to the digital data. These items should be sent to Central Records at your earliest convenience. I am available to answer any mapping question in the meantime. Thank you.

In addition, it is my understanding that an agreement was reached with City of Portland, and therefore the revised maps and digital data should also reflect the outcome of those discussions. I'll be looking forward to the latest copies of the following items being submitted to Central Records:

A general location map identifying the requested area in reference to the nearest county boundary, city, or town.

□ A detailed map identifying the requested area in reference to verifiable man-made and natural landmarks, such as roads, rivers, and railroads.

Digital mapping data for the requested area, as a single polygon record, in shapefile (SHP) format, georeferenced in either NAD83 Texas Statewide Mapping System (Meters) or NAD83 Texas State Plane Coordinate System (US Feet); **OR**

metes and bounds survey sealed or embossed by either a licensed state surveyor or a registered professional land surveyor.


Mr. Castaneda,
